Salah Jassim Murad and Ahli Bank win CEO Leadership Achievement and Best Managed Bank in Qatar Awards

Singapore's OCBC Bank, Hong Kong's The Bank of East Asia, and Indonesia's Bank Central Asia also amongst 12 banks picked out for this triennial assessment of leadership and management capabilities of Asian and Middle Eastern banks

Hanoi, Vietnam, May 10th 2016 – Salah Jassim Murad and Ahli Bank received the CEO Leadership Achievement and Best Managed Bank in Qatar Awards at the prestigious Asian Banker Leadership Achievement Awards held at JW Marriott Hanoi on 10th May 2016.

The awards were presented to Murad by Congressman Barney Frank, former chairman of the US House Financial Services Committee. Also present were Nguyen Thi Hong, deputy governor of State Bank of Vietnam; and Cesar Virata, a member of the advisory council that decides on the award, and the former prime minister of the Philippines.

Bank Ahli underwent a significant change in ownership in January 2013 and continues to maintain its position as a top-tier, top-of-mind bank in Qatar. Under Murad's leadership, the bank realised a compound annual growth rate of 11% and average return on equity of 15.1% from 2013 to 2015.

He decoupled the bank's systems and processes, and created a new brand identity and awareness to drive a change in mindset and approach across the bank. He also implemented the necessary controls and governance procedures to make this transition seamless.

Murad has over 30 years of experience in commercial banking and has been the CEO of Ahli Bank QSC since 2013.
